## Scottish Surfing Junior Series

There will be 4 events in the 2025 Junior Series.

3 results will be counted towards the overall series.

There will be 1-3<sup>rd</sup> prizes for the overall series winners.

All SSF Junior Series events will be seeded by the most recent series leaderboard standings in that division. Any athletes unseeded in a division will be given a seeding based on their order of online entry.

Competitors are permitted to enter 2 divisions in the Scottish Junior National Surfing Championships and 1 division in the other Junior Series Events (please refer to page 7 for Scottish National Team Qualification / Selection).

## Scottish National Surfing Championships

The Scottish National Surfing Championships takes place annually over easter weekend.

The previous year's rankings from the Scottish National Surfing Championships will be used to seed entries to the Scottish National Surfing Championships. Any athletes unseeded in a division will be given a seeding based on their order of online entry.

## Scottish National Longboard Championships

Previous year's rankings from the Scottish National Surfing Championships will be used to seed entries to the event where possible. Any athletes unseeded in a division will be given a seeding based on their order of online entry.

## Gathering of the Clans

The Gathering of the Clans is the Scottish-Interclub Team Championships.

Only Scottish Surfing Affiliated Surf Clubs may enter teams into the Gathering of the Clans.

The previous year's team ranking from the Gathering of the Clans will be used to seed entries for each division followed by the individual seeding provided to the SSF from each club. So if Club A won the Gathering of the Clans the previous year, their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> seeded athletes would take the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> seed in the draw in that division. Any unseeded teams will be seeded on order of their entry.

## Scottish Universities Surfing Championships (SUSC)

Only SSF affiliated University surf clubs may enter teams into SUSC

The previous year's team ranking from SUSC will be used to seed entries for each division followed by the individual seeding provided to the SSF from each club. So if Uni A won SUSC the previous year, their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> seeded athletes would take the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> seed in the draw in that division. Any unseeded teams will be seeded on order of their entry.

# Rulebook

The ISA Rulebook will be adhered to at all times in all SSF Sanctioned events.

## Protest

1. At times errors of a special nature may occur with respect to the running of the contest. This includes but is not limited to: heat timing, interference directly attributable to an officiating error, tabulating errors, missed wave, etc. Any competitor, manager or team coach has the right to protest the result of a heat due to any of the above. Protests must be **in writing** and must be submitted to the Contest Director by the athlete, manager or coach within 15 minutes of the heat results being released.
2. The merits of each protest will be considered by the Contest Director after consultation with the Head Judge. Qualified observers (off-duty judges, spotter, and senior officials) may be asked for their advice. The Contest Director will rule on the incident and inform the surfer's manager of the decision.
3. NOTE: No protest can be lodged against a judging (scoring) decision. Wave scores of the judges are irrevocable. No Head Judge, Scoring Judge, or Priority Judge is to be approached over a score, a decision or the results. If so, a penalty may be imposed by the Contest Director on the individual or team involved.

## Conduct

Athletes, coaches, managers and officials should conduct themselves in a professional manner at SSF events. The contest director's decision is final and any disputes should be made in writing to the SSF and not by social media.
